Adult Safeguarding E-Learning Programme

LEVEL ONE

A two hour course

Course Aim

The course has been developed to provide an introductory overview into Adult Safeguarding. It provides the learner with knowledge of the categories, indicators, reporting process and local and national policy and procedures relating to Adult Safeguarding.

Target Group

Cambridgeshire County Council staff, partner agencies, residential services, health and social care providers, charities and voluntary organisations that work, or may come into contact with vulnerable adults within Cambridgeshire.

Learning Objectives

By the end of this course participants will be able to:

- ❖ Define who are vulnerable adults in accordance with 'No Secrets' 2000
- ❖ Describe types and indicators of abuse
- ❖ List risk factors which increase the likelihood of abuse
- ❖ Outline the process for reporting abuse
- ❖ Describe good practice when recording safeguarding concerns
- ❖ Identify local and national policy and guidance which govern the safeguarding of adults

There is a multiple choice quiz at the end of this training package, which, on completion, provides the learner with the opportunity to print off a certificate. The quiz comprises of 20 questions and is a useful tool in demonstrating a learners understanding. **It is advised that a pass mark of 18 is achieved.** If the learner is not successful in achieving this, the whole course should be retaken, or, the specific section/s which relate to their gaps in knowledge. The quiz should then be completed and another certificate issued.
