Cambridgeshire Care Brokerage distributed a learning needs questionnaire to all 419 care providers on its database. We do this in order to find out what the learning and development needs are in the region and where funding may be required now and in the future.

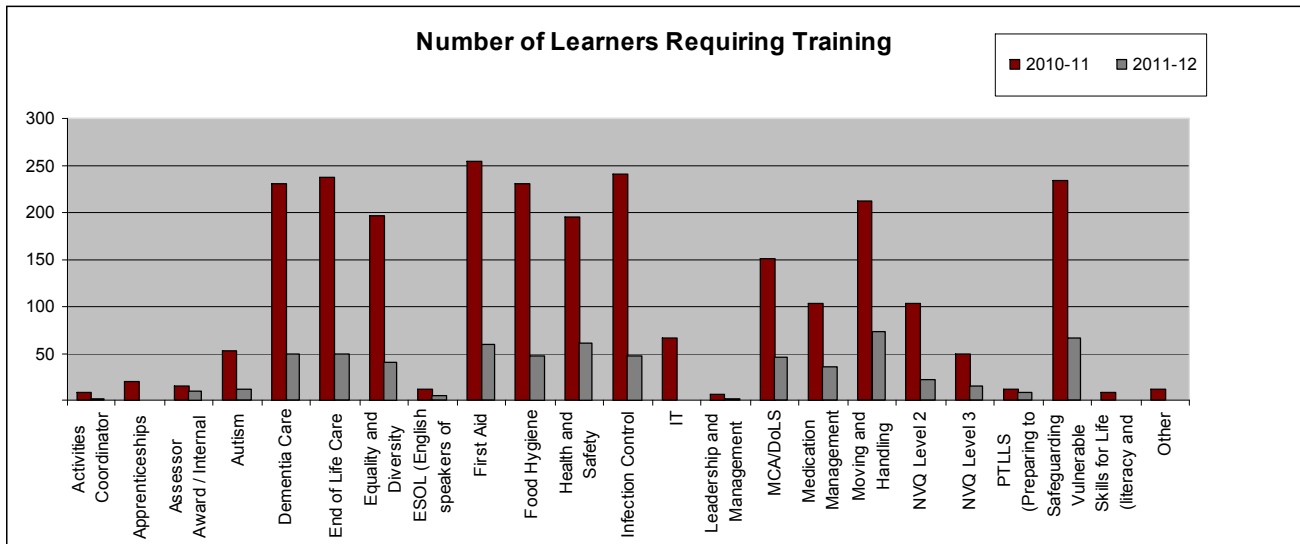
Number of Training Needs survey distributed: 424
