

EAR, NOSE, EYE DROPS / OINTMENTS & INHALED MEDICINES - A WORKSHOP FOR LINE MANAGERS

½ DAY TRAINING COURSE

This is a short course designed to give the line manager or senior staff member the knowledge and skills required to assess the competency of other care staff to safely administer ear, nose, eye drops / ointments and inhaled medicines. During the course you will receive up to date information, the competency framework and have an assessment of your competency in these techniques.

Staff wishing to attend this training must have received “Application of Ear, Nose, Eye Drops & Inhaled Medication” training before commencing this course.

The course will include:

- An overview of the ‘Competency Framework for the Administration of Drops / Ointments and Inhaled Medicines to Individuals’.
- A practical session that includes the demonstration of safe techniques to administer the following in line with the competency framework:
 - Eye Drops / Ointments
 - Nose Drops / Sprays
 - Ear Drops
 - Inhalers
- A demonstration of the aids / products available for self-administration of eye drops and inhalers.

This training course is directed by the Medicines Management Domiciliary & Care Home Group.
